Describe who you are as a teacher and how that impacts your attitudes about teaching.



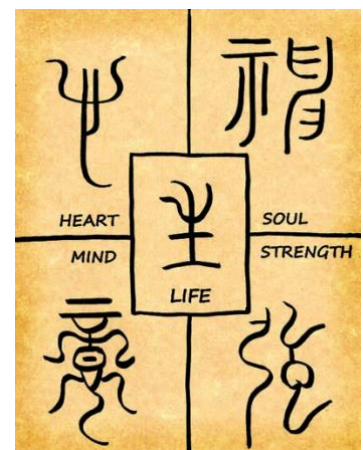
Week 2 – The Calling of the Teacher
